Dear Parents,

This is to inform you that we have shared you grade X CBSE board time table of all papers. The exam centre is Shantiniketan, Kolhapur. This circular aims to inform you that if parents are willing to drop and pick up your ward to the exam centre on your own you are supposed to give the consent letter to school about the same. Such parents should follow the timings very strictly. The reporting time to the exam centre is on or before 9.a.m., once the exam gets over, in order to pick up your ward you must reach the exam centre (Shantiniketan) at 1.45.p.m.

All those students who wish to come by school bus to the exam centre and not on their own should report the school (SVYEMS) at 8.00 a.m. After exam, all students will reach back the school by 2.45 p.m. From school to home there is no special dropping facility. Parents can come to school and collect their own ward (at 2.45 p.m.) If you are not able to pick them up, your ward will be dropped by regular school buses at regular time i.e. after school gets over (5.30 pm onwards) He needs to wait in the school till 5.30 p.m.

23rd March, being Saturday(English paper) all the parents are expected to pick up their ward from school (SVYEMS) around 2.45 p.m. Saturday being holiday there won't be school buses available.

As mentioned earlier, parents are free to escort their ward to the exam centre on their own. We request you to send your written consent on or before Tuesday 26th February 2019 without fail so that we will plan the things accordingly

Here are some important Directions for the students/parents appearing for AISSE-2018-19

- Absolute discipline in and outside the examination hall should be maintained.
- No unfair means (in any form) to be practised.
- No calculator, No wrist watches no writing pad and no any electrical gadgets to be carried.
- Parents are not allowed to enter the campus.
- Transparent water bottle, transparent pouch and pencil box is allowed.
- The candidates must bring their own pens, pencils, scales, eraser etc. Borrowing from other candidate is not permitted.
- Hall ticket and ID is compulsory.
- No celebrations in the premises of the centre(especially on the last day of exam)
